6. Matters Arising
 - 6.1 Parish Clerk has chased up response from Cheshire East Council regarding the removal of the Hatherton sign from the end of Park Lane and the 7.5 ton limit request on Park Lane – **no further correspondence received to date**
 - 6.2 Clerk advised that consultation is in progress with a representative from Scottish Power in relation to the street light on the Boar's Head crossroads being restored back to working order - **ongoing**
 - 6.3 The SID device on Audlem Road, Hatherton, has still not been repaired despite two letters to Cheshire East Council advising them of the damage. Ward Cllr Janet Clowes to follow this up. – **Ward Cllr Janet Clowes to give progress report**
 - 6.4 The switch of the Parish bank account from RBS to the Co-op was rejected by the Co-op. Parish Clerk is in consultation with the Co-op to discuss alternative options
 - 6.5 Parish Clerk has wrote to the Paragon Group (landlords of The Boar's Head) to ask if they will fund a litter bin to be sited at the lay-by opposite the Boar's Head - **No response to date**
 - 6.6 Councillor Knibbs to arrange supply and siting of new parish notice board at Boar's head – **Councillor Knibbs to provide update**
 - 6.7 The suggestion of siting a bench in the lay-by at the end of Park Lane at the start of the Hatherton – Woolfall – Hunsterson Loop walk has been refused by Cheshire East Council as to near to a main road – **Parish Clerk has appealed this decision due to the fact that the area chosen is currently in use as a bus stop.**
 - 6.8 Parish Clerk has contacted Cheshire East with regards to the number of housing signs and other unauthorised signage appearing around the Parish – **The enquiry has been taken up by the Planning Enforcement Team and an incident number allocated**
